\$2,400.00	Empowered Voices Media Project	Establish a SmartAccess field center at Sisters of the Road and train Sisters' community members as Portland Community Media Producers, enabling them to create videos that build community by breaking down stereotypes and increasing awareness of the real experiences of people who are unhoused and/or living in poverty. These videos will be featured in a film festival open to the community.
